

Minutes of First PTM Dated 21/04/2025

- Ms. Rashmi Pardeshi extended a warm welcome to all the members attending the first PTA meeting of the academic year 2025–2026. She then proceeded to introduce all the PTA representatives, class-wise, providing their names and the standards they represent
- Followed by the introduction of the new PTA committee members, Ms. Rashmi Pardeshi extended a cordially welcome to Dr. Sanjay Roy and invited him to commence the day's meeting.
- Dr. Roy warmly welcomed all the PTA members and provided a comprehensive introduction to the recent renovations and improvements in the school's infrastructure. He highlighted the key changes that will be made during the summer vacation to enhance the learning environment, including upgraded classrooms and improved washrooms.
- Dr. Sanjay Roy told, about the installation of new smart boards in classrooms. These upgrades aim to eliminate the health concerns associated with traditional teaching tools—specifically, reducing exposure to chalk dust and marker ink fumes, which may cause issues among students and staff.
- Sir Roy enlightened the parents that the summer break will commence from April 22, 2025.
- Sir Roy informed the PTA members during the monsoons it is compulsory for students to wear black flouters and gumboots. The use of fancy footwear is strictly not permitted the kids are not allowed to wear any fancy watches only simple black small dial chronicle watches.
- Grooming Guidelines given by Sir Roy for the Students - Boys are expected to maintain a proper haircut. Hair should not fall below the eyebrows and hair strands
- Girls with long hair must keep their hair neatly plaited and secure with proper hairbands. It's mandatory for girls to wear cycling shorts.
- Application of mehndi (henna) is allowed only on the palms and strictly with prior written permission from Sir Roy. A written application must be submitted and approved in advance.
- Uniforms must be neatly ironed, and students are required to wear the new uniforms and shoes provided by the school every year.
- Fancy water bottles, tiffin boxes, and compass boxes are strictly not allowed in school.
- Sir Roy has informed the PTA that the school concert will be held in the month of December. Students of Std 10 will not be participating in the concert performances as they are expected to focus on their upcoming board exams. However, they will be involved in backstage duties and event coordination on the day of the concert.
- Parents are requested to strictly adhere to the tuition timings for Secondary section after 03:30 PM as teachers may ask students to stay back after school if needed.
- On request of Sir Roy, Ms. Pradnya has been informed to the PTA that the students of Standard 10 will be attending a workshop on 22nd April 2025 as part of the I.I.M.U.N Role Model Series. This is a great opportunity for students to gain insights and inspiration from influential role models.
- Sir Roy announced that the terminal examinations are tentatively scheduled for September 10th or 11th, 2025. The school has organized an educational trip to Hyderabad, which will include visits to the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and Ramoji Film City. This trip aims to provide students with valuable exposure to India's advancements in space research and the film industry. The kids will be travelling round the trip by train to Hyderabad. And educational trips are compulsory.
- Taekwondo has been introduced this year for students from Standard 1 to 10, every alternate week.
- Sir Roy specifically mentioned - The parents are requested to communicate with their children in English, which enhances their vocabulary and communication skills as the kids write all their exam papers in the English Language.

- Sir Roy mentioned that he wants to introduce Sanskrit in the school but due to lack of a qualified Sanskrit teacher he was unable to do so.
- Mrs. Shilpa Mishra, parent of Shrestha Mishra (Grade 10), asked whether students are permitted to wear black Crocs during the monsoon season as some kids feel uncomfortable in the floaters. For that, Sir Roy replied if a child wants to wear crocs, he or she can wear black croaks. She also asked for Grade10th's portion Term1 for which Sir Roy replied that, it will be sent in the month of June like every year.
- Mr.Gathani asked Sir Roy can the primary kids join the educational trip to Hyderabad for which Sir Roy replied the primary kids are too young for the overnight trips. He added that he might plan a trip to NASA when his child reaches the secondary section.
