

- v) Name another plant that belongs to this special group of plants which contains or bears sticky substances for trapping insects.

Q1b) Differentiate between the following terms using only the keywords (5marks) given in the brackets.

- i) Incident ray and Reflected ray (definition)
- ii) Inflammable and Non-flammable substances (ability to catch fire)
- iii) Metals and Non-Metals (lustre)
- iv) Solid and Gas (volume)
- v) Photosynthesis and Respiration (end product released)

Q2a) Alex wants to have his favourite pickles for lunch but the metal lid of the glass jar just doesn't seem to open. Finally he decides to experiment with some hot water and he pours on the lid of the glass jar. Observe the picture carefully and answer the questions that follow: (5 marks)

- ii) How does pouring hot water help?
- iii) What will happen if instead of hot water, cold water is poured over the metal lid?
- iv) Which property of solids finds its application in the glass jar example?
- v) Define temperature.
