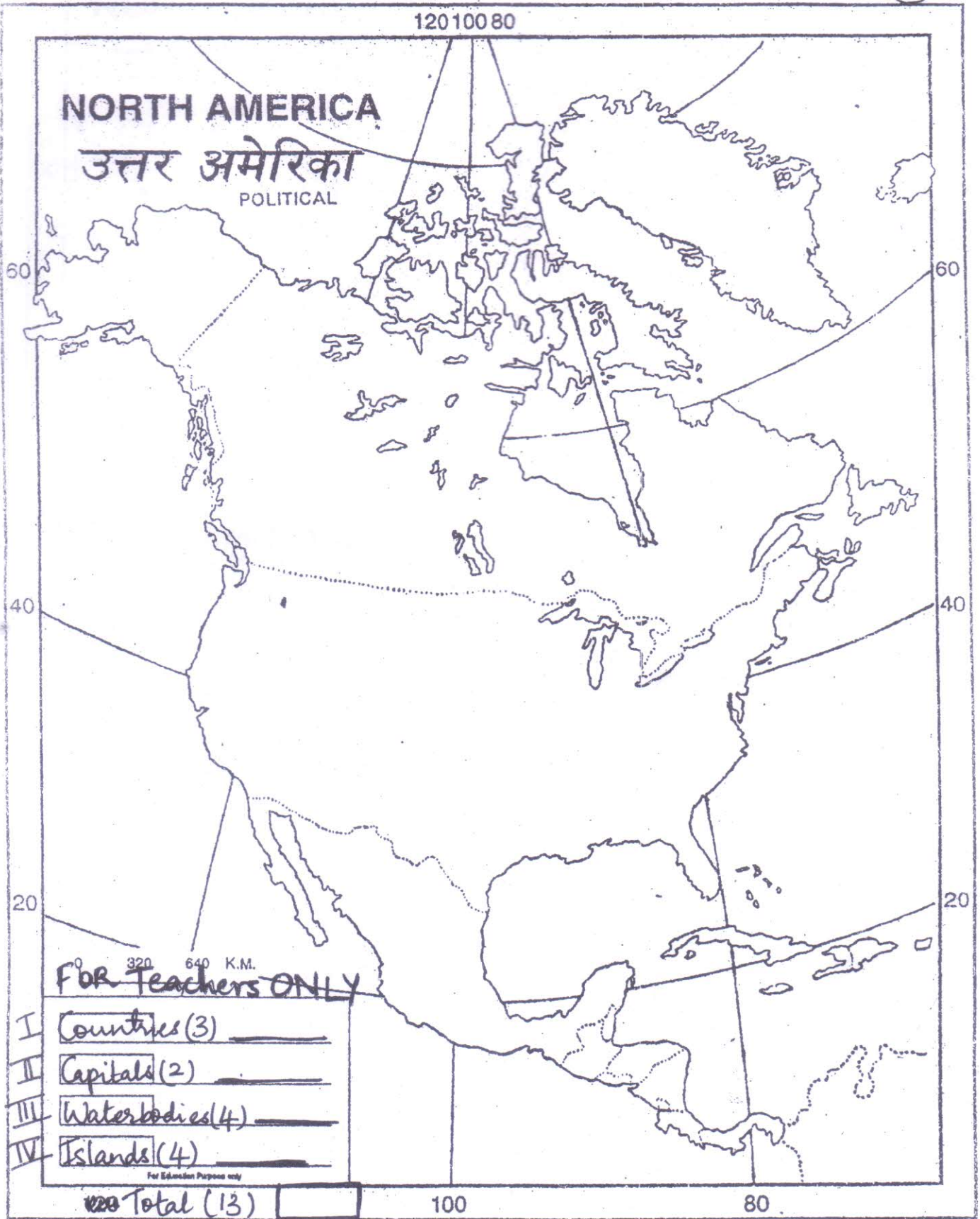

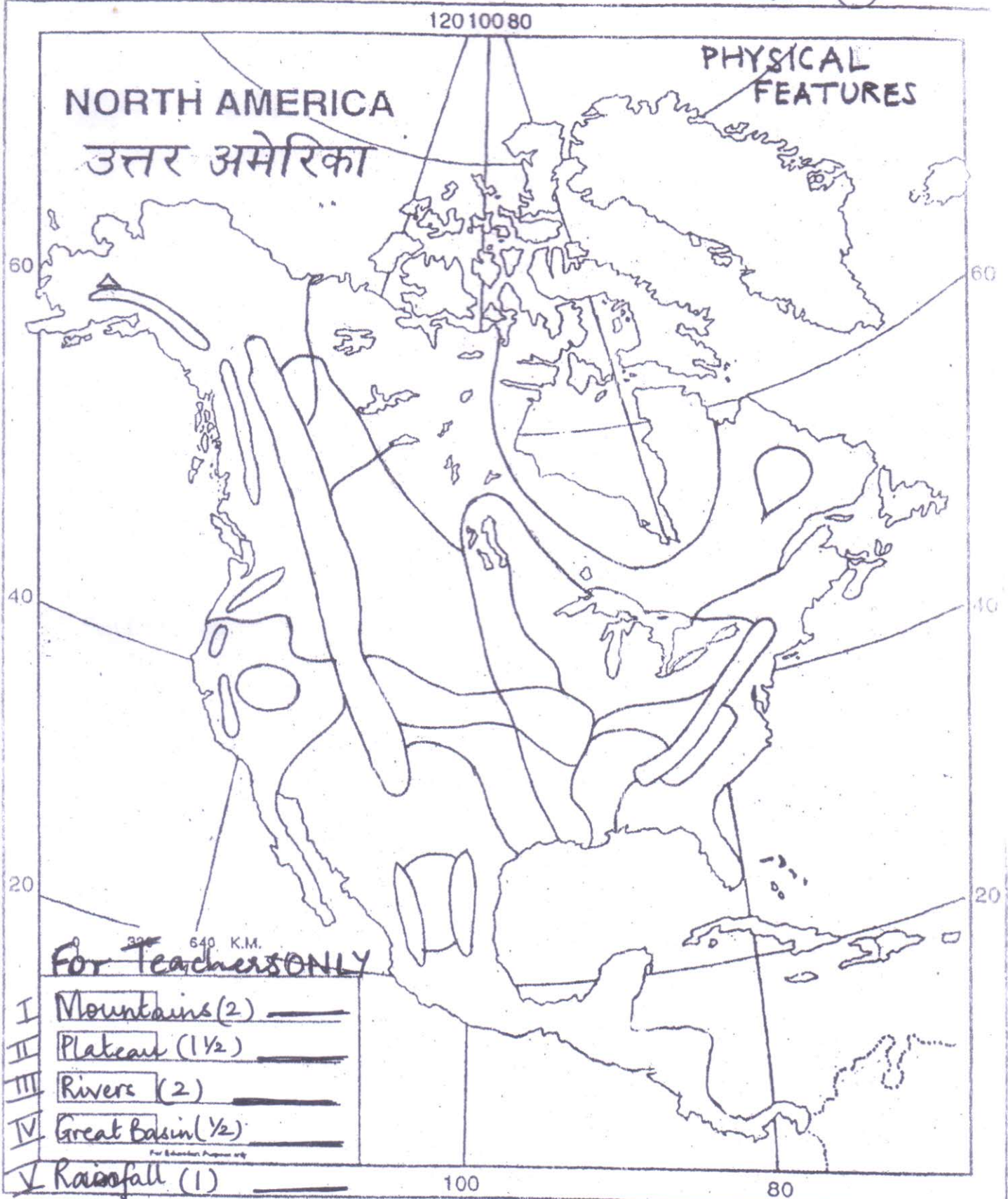
MAP (A)
