## Minutes of 3<sup>rd</sup> AGM meeting 2022-2023

1. Ms Shivani welcomed everyone present and read the agenda of the meeting.
  2. Ms Shivani read aloud the minutes of the 2nd PTA meeting and Mrs. Shorewala seconded the minutes of the meeting.
  3. Ms Shivani invited Dr Sanjay Roy to address the parents and he welcomed all for the AGM meeting.
  4. Dr Sanjay Roy spoke of the excellent ICSE results and that the Offline School has added to the chirping of voices and happy faces in the corridors of the school. He mentioned that Krish Jain and Veer Jain have secured the highest percentage of 97.5% in the ICSE Board Examination and out of 31 children who appeared for the board examination, 19 children scored more than 90%. It speaks volumes for our school. The rest of them were all above 80% and only 1 child scored 79%.
  5. Dr Sanjay Roy informed the parents that it is not just the academics they are excelling in but also learning to take responsibilities as recently ours was the only school In the North and South of Bombay to have participated in the beach cleaning drive. We made headlines in the Times of India and NIE. Our children are responsible enough and they are all standing up and rising as they know the need of the hour. He further added that this would not have been possible without the support of the parents and the teachers.

6. Dr Sanjay Roy said that the teachers have put in their hardwork day in and day out during the COVID days. The teachers who were not tech friendly sat up whole night and prepared their lessons. There were times when they could not check the work of their own children as they were busy preparing for the next day's schedule so that the education of the child does not suffer.
7. Dr Sanjay Roy cited the importance of extracurricular activities as he highlighted the student's achievements at National and International level, moreover at Inter School Competitions children have won prizes and made us proud. He informed that two of our children Namaha Kangutkar and her brother Swastik Kangutkar have entered the Guinness Book of World Records for solving the rubic cube in less than a minute. Arnav Shinde of Std VIII has won the silver medal in the boxing tournament at the National Level. This is happening for the first time in Greenlawns as we are opening to different sports.
8. Dr Sanjay Roy informed the parents that this year we had the Greenlawns Summit organized by Ms Reema we had around 30 to 40 competitions. There were competitions ranging from Chess to test their mental ability as well as other that could test their physical ability. Arm Wrestling, and even Fashion Designing and many others were included in this Summit.
9. Dr Sanjay Roy further added that children who are introvert get a platform to showcase their talent without feeling shy. We want to hone their skills and bring out leadership qualities. The planning for the Greenlawns Summit took two days and it was executed within three days. The children had a gala time during this Summit. We are trying to implement new things so that our children are not left behind in this changing world.
10. Dr Sanjay Roy informed the parents that a child from Grade IX Aanandi Sawant went onto represent the state of Maharashtra at the National Level in Gymnastics at Juhu there she stood 4<sup>th</sup>. Veeraj Nadar of Std V who came first in the Skating Tournament. Kian Desai of Std VI won the gold in the Taekwondo Tournament at the district level and went onto win the silver at the National Level.
11. Dr Sanjay Roy stated that we are leaving a mark whether it is at the State Level, National Level or the competitions like Cascade at Jamnabai where we had won 3 prizes. We won prizes at Melange and Preferentia. Our children are trying their best and this would not have been possible without the support of the wonderful parents.
12. Dr Sanjay Roy informed them that this year we have introduced Robotics and Coding in line with the NEP 2020-2022. We are ahead of times as we have made it compulsory as it is a way to the future.
13. Dr Sanjay Roy informed the parents that Spanish and Russian will be taught by the consulate faculty in future and French has already begun this year.

14. Dr Sanjay Roy shared the experience of the children's recent Panchgani trip where they visited the village camps and saw firsthand the way the underprivileged children led their lives. They played games with the children like tug of war and had a gala time. They even learnt to make shoes and how they are trying to emerge from the situation. Our children are sitting in the air conditioned rooms and there are children who do not get these facilities and are still doing wonders. It was an eye opening experience for them.
15. Dr Sanjay Roy reminded the parents about the fee hike proposed for the year 2023-24 and 2024-25 this was 15% fee hike and the last years concession of ₹20,000 was due to the benevolence of our management.
16. Dr Sanjay Roy advised the PTA committee to come up with new ideas for the events such as Funfair, Navratri or any other.
17. Dr Sanjay Roy informed the parents that his doors are always open for them to come and meet him anytime and they do not require an appointment as he mentioned that he is always there for his children. In order for the school to be a happy place it cannot be without the support of the parents.
18. Dr Sanjay Roy said that the child can progress with parents on one side and teachers on the other side like a potter sculpting the pot. Let us make them like a beautiful vase.
19. Dr Sanjay Roy informed the parents that the exams are starting from the 15th of September and they must take care of the children in the best possible way. They must not compare their children with others. They cannot snap at the child or hit or shout at them this will only disturb the atmosphere as today's times are different. He said that the older generation always touched their parents' feet and kept them on the pedestal but today things are different and they will question you for everything. He advised the parents to use humour and be a friend to the child.
20. Dr Sanjay Roy told the parents that copying or any unethical means used during the examination would result in zero. He also said that the children talk of other things like the clashes at home or any other matter that disturbs them and they come to the cabin and reveal that to him.
21. Dr Sanjay Roy spoke about the Japanese exchange program may happen in the near future. He also added that due to the war in Russia the exchange program has been stalled.
22. After Dr Sanjay Roy, Ms Shivani invited Ms Mubarakha Ghadiyalli to share her thoughts.

23. Ms Mubaraka Ghadiyalli spoke of the efficient working of the school and congratulated the Trustees, the Principal and the teachers as we managed beautifully during the pandemic and even the Offline School.
24. Ms Shivani invited the queries and the Std III parent Mrs. Punalekar parent of Parth Punalekar said that during monsoon it is not possible to go out to play on the ground so can they have chess classes. Dr Sanjay Roy said that he will look into the matter.
