

## The Minutes of the Third PTA Meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> September,2024

Third Parents teachers' association meeting for the academic year 2024-25 was conducted on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2024.

- Ms. Rama Priya Sinha welcomed all the PTA members and read the Agenda of the Meeting.
- Heeding the norm, Ms. Rama read out the minutes of the first PTA meeting of academic year 2024-25 held on 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2024.
- The minutes of the meeting were seconded by Mrs. Prajakta Punalekar (Parth) and Mrs. Nazneen Kutar (Farzad).
- Then Ms. Rama invited the Principal Dr. Sanjay Roy to take over the meeting.
- In his speech Dr. Roy announced the Agenda of the meeting as:  
**'Revision of Fees'**.
- Dr. Roy started by displaying an Excel sheet on the monitor regarding the revised fee structure for the academic years 2025'26 and 2026'27.
- Sir Roy said that the proposed fees that the school has given for the academic year 2025'26 and 2026'27 (in accordance with the Government rules of 15% hike) is:
  - i. **13% Hike** for the **Primary Section**, and
  - ii. **12% Hike** for the **Secondary Section**which comes out as :
  - a. **Rs. 1, 27,650** for the **Primary Section**
  - b. **Rs. 1,33,475** for the **Secondary Section**, for the academic years 2025'26 and 2026'27.
- Sir Roy then requested the parents to have a look at the proposed fee structure. He added that he wanted them to be very clear about the same and hence had sent a notice regarding it earlier. He also prepared the Excel sheet to display on the screen for the parents.
- Sir Roy requested the PTA members to give their approval by raising their hands.
- All PTA members and class teachers have given their consent.
- Sir Roy appreciated this gesture and thanked them for giving their unanimous consent, for showing trust in him and in the school. He added that it means a lot to him.
- In the end, Dr. Roy asked the members to raise their question, if any, regarding the Agenda.
- Queries related to ventilation of classrooms, early dispersal of children during Ganpati Visarjan were raised. Sir said that he would look into the matter. He was humble to give early dispersal to the children the very same day and gave a holiday to the Primary Section the next day. Secondary Section also got a Half Day the next day on account of Gauri Visarjan.
- Dr. Roy ended the meeting by thanking Dr. Caroline, and all present there for taking their valuable time out and giving support to the school.
- Ms Rama requested the parents to stay back for 10 minutes for signing the approval sheet.
