The Minutes of the AGM Of PTA Meet held on 27th September, 2024

Sir Roy added further that it would be of no surprise to him if Arnav wins Medals in the Olympics representing India, in the coming future.
- Dr Roy said that Arnav Shinde has recently won a Gold Medal in entire Mumbai DSO-Championship. He congratulated him once again and his parents, who have been the main credentials behind his success.
- Dr Roy was proud to announce that Kian Desai of Std 8 has won a Gold Medal in the World Championship in Taekwondo.
- Dr Roy went on to mention that Veeraj Nadar of Std 7 has won Gold Medals in Skating and Running.
- Dr Roy thanked all the parents for believing in the school and handing over their children to us. He also thanked the teachers as he felt that without their support, achieving this would not have been possible.
- Dr Roy went ahead to state that the last meeting was about the fee hike for the years 2025-26 and 2026-27 and that we have got a 100% approval for the same.
- Dr Roy said that the Annual Concert would be held on 10th December, 2024 for which he requested parents to encourage children to participate in large numbers.
- Dr Roy mentioned that there would be Career Counselling arranged for students of Std 8 and Std 10. While Std 8 children would be guided about their choice of subjects in Std 9 and Std 10, students of Std 10 would find it helpful in deciding which career they would pursue when they pass out Std 10.
- > Dr Roy announced that the Sports Day would be held on 16th December, 2024.
- Apart from these events, Sir Roy requested the PTA to come up with Garba Night and Funfair events and make them as wonderful as usual.
- Dr Roy stated that the school Edusprint app is updating to Edusprint Pro. Teachers would be sending the link for parents to download the same very soon.

- In the end, Dr. Roy thanked Ms. Caroline and all the parents for their consistent support, be it in academics, in Sports or in whatever decision the school takes. He thanked the Trustees and the Management without whom this entire show would not run. He then asked the members to raise their question, if any.
- Queries related to the dates of Annual Concert and Sports Day being very close to each other were raised.

To this, Dr Roy replied that it depends on the availability of the ground and the availability of the auditorium. He mentioned that although he wanted to push the Sports Day a little more ahead, he couldn't due to unavailability of the Sports Ground. He added that if there is any possibility regarding the same, he would surely let them know.
